

# Beijing Jiaotong University

## I. University Profile

Located in downtown Beijing, capital city of China, and established in 1896, Beijing Jiaotong University (a.k.a. Northern Jiaotong University) is a multidisciplinary national key university, leading in communication and information engineering, economics and management, and traffic and transportation, with Signal and Information Processing and Traffic Information Engineering and Control ranked No. 1 in China. BJTU has about 14,000 full-time undergraduate students and 6,000 graduate students. BJTU started to recruit international students in 1954 and has educated up to 3,000 international students from 71 countries. In 2006 Over 220 international students from 55 countries are studying at BJTU.

1. Admission requirements

Chinese Language Learning	Academic record equivalent to a Chinese secondary school certificate
Undergraduate	Academic record equivalent to a Chinese secondary school certificate, HSK 4, pass of first year trial study
Master's	Bachelor's Degree or equivalent, 2 recommendations by associate professors or above, under review
Ph.D.	Master's Degree or equivalent, 2 recommendations by associate professors or above, under review
General Further Study	More than two years of formal university education, studying on relevant subjects
Senior Further Study	Master's Degree or associate professorship and above, studying on a specific topic

2. Schedule

- 1) Fall 2007: Application deadline is June 30, 2007; entry date is September 1, 2007.
- 2) Spring 2008: Application deadline is December 31, 2007; entry date is March 1, 2008.
- 3) Chinese language programs accept applications and entries throughout the year.
- 4) Summer Chinese language course is available from July 2 to August 10, 2007.

3. Application materials (photocopy, facsimiled copy and scanned copy sent by e-mail are acceptable at application)

- 1) Application Form completely filled up;
- 2) Diploma and transcripts, originals should be produced at registration;
- 3) Financial Guarantee signed by a person with legal capacity;
- 4) Health certificate issued by a public hospital;
- 5) Passport photocopy (if not available at application, fax or email it before leaving for China).
